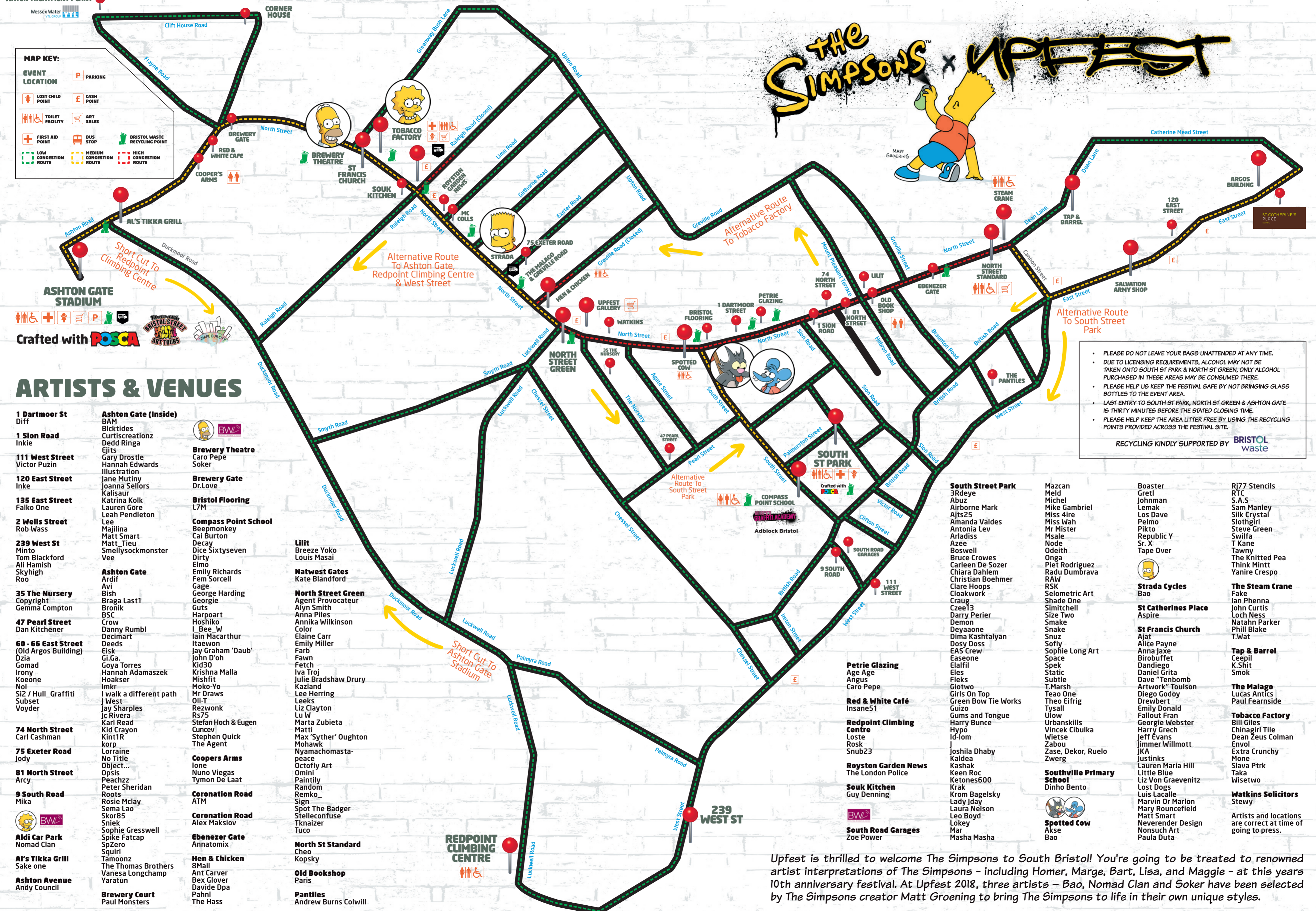

UPFEST 2018 ARTIST - JODY

Jody is a Bristol based aerosol artist, he began painting in 1987 at the now infamous Barton Hill Youth Club in Bristol. He became renown for his strong black and white figurative style which at the time stood out alongside other Bristol luminaries: Inkie, Cheo and Banksy. After a long 18 year break he was interviewed for the book 'Children of the Can - 25 Years of Bristol Graffiti' in 2008 by Felix Braun, and was brought out of his hiatus. His work takes inspiration from fashion and film and takes a strong, graphic and noirish take on photorealistic portraits and figurative subjects. His work seeks to explore themes of emotional depth that lurk under the glossy surface through a dark glamorous aesthetic.

His work has been exhibited around the world and published in numerous books and magazines his clients include Harvey Nichols, Adidas, The Florist and The Colston Hall.
